The 2019 IEL Leadership Academy begins with a mandatory retreat in Houston on Thursday, September 20, 2018 from noon to 9:00 p.m. and on Friday, September 21, 2018 from 7:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. If the mandatory meeting is missed, individuals will not be permitted to continue in the Leadership Academy, but may be considered for a future Leadership Academy.

The program also requires attendance at either the 3rd National Young Energy Professionals' Law Conference in Spring 2019 (location likely Austin) or the 70th Annual Oil and Gas Law Conference on February 21-22, 2019, in Houston, although it is strongly recommended that participants attend both conferences. The registration fee for these two additional events is included in the registration fee for the leadership class. Other optional distance based programming and small meetings will also be held.
